Events & Activities by GSA

Certifications

A certification course on "Python Advanced" was conducted by Kartheek G C R of Gopalan Skill Academy from 6th Sept 2023 to 30th Sept 2023. It was a four weeks program which was open for all. The course focused on providing students with advanced concepts of python language along with fundamental knowledge. Emphasis was given on hands-on training and problem solving using python.









One month certification course on "Learn SQL in 30 days" was conducted from Gopalan skill Academy from 18th October 2023 to 15 November 2023. 

Another reason is that tigers are using their natural habitat. Only 7% of original tiger habits are still intact today. But India has the largest tiger population of 2967 Tigers. This is 70% of the worldwide population of tigers.

- They weigh about 800.278 pounds.
- A cub can only hunt on its own after turning two or three.

International Tiger Day timeline

- 1973 Project Tiger: India launches Project Tiger to rescue the tiger population.
- 2010 Project TX2. It was launched 13 tiger range countries commit to TX2 to double wild tiger numbers by 2022.
- 2017 2 tiger subspecies are listed: ICUN recognizes the Continental tiger and Sunda island tiger as subspecies.
- 2022 Year of the Tiger: WWF aims to double the number of wild tigers in 2022.


